May 4, 2019 Specially Called Joint Meeting



The Board of Commissioners for the Town of Webster and the Town of Webster Planning Board held an informal Joint Work Session on Saturday May 4, 2019 for the purpose of doing landscape work at the WWII Monument for the Jackson County Municipal Grant Project.

CALL TO ORDER

Work began at approximately 9:30 a.m. with no official Call to Order.

WORK PROJECT

Council Members, Planning Board Members, and volunteers met at the WWII Memorial to work on landscaping around the monument as part of the Jackson County Municipal Grant. Plants were selected at Country Roads Nursery earlier that morning. The addition of Redbud tree was discussed as a possible backdrop addition at the site. Existing shrubs were removed and kept for use at the East Welcome sign. Old mulch was removed, planting beds were weeded, the footprint of the planting area was expanded, and new shrubs and flowers were planted. The work day provided an opportunity for community involvement with the project and social outreach for the Board. Justin Woodard, the Town's landscaper, donated his time and equipment from 8 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. for the project. Mayor Rodes thanked all volunteers for their participation during the workday. Special thanks to Walter Turner for spreading mulch at a later date.
